

Learn about the construction process for a new transmission project in your area. Eversource and National Grid are hosting a Community Meeting for Hudson residents to learn more about this phase of the Merrimack Valley Reliability Project (MVRP).

The new, 24.5 mile, 345-kV overhead transmission line will stretch from Londonderry, NH to Tewksbury, MA, and will be constructed by Eversource and National Grid. The Companies have received approval to construct the MVRP from the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee (NH SEC) and the Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities (MA DPU).
