

The Town of Hudson has contracted SOLitude Lake Management, 590 Lake Street, Shrewsbury, MA 01545, Telephone 508-885-0101, to treat portions of Otternic Pond in Hudson with USEPA/State registered herbicides Clipper (flumioxazin), EPA Registration Number 59639-161 and CleanAmine (liquid 2,4-D amine), EPA Registration Number 34704-120, to control exotic variable milfoil and fanwort weeds.

A permit application has been filed with the state requesting approval for this treatment program. The treatment will likely be performed in mid to late June 2016. If a permit is issued, there will be additional notification of the actual treatment date and specific information on certain activities and water uses that will be temporarily restricted as a condition of the permit. Any questions concerning the proposed treatment should be directed to SOLitude Lake Management at the above address.

Those wishing to comment on the proposed application may contact the New Hampshire Department of Agriculture, Division of Pesticide Control to request a public hearing. Comments must be received in writing within 15 days of receipt of this notice.


