

## ITINERARY

Day One: On this 4 day Pennsylvania tour, you will get to experience some of the great things that this part of the country has to offer such as the Amish Countryside, Sight and Sound Theatre with "Jonah", and of course delectable meals! Your group will be picked up at their usual pick up points. You will have rest stops and a luncheon stop en route (on your own) along the way. Your 3-night hotel accommodations will be conveniently located in the Heart of Lancaster County, known to specialize in comfort, cleanliness, and country charm. You will have time to relax before your dinner at a local restaurant. Prepare your taste buds for some delicious traditional Penn Dutch cooking!

Day Two: Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning. We will be leaving early for our tour of Philadelphia. Your group will have a guided tour of this historic city hearing about some of these things that make Philly great- the Liberty Bell, the Declaration of Independence, and Philly cheesesteaks. You will also be visiting One Liberty Observation Deck-Philly from the Top. Lunch today will be on your own. After lunch, you will be traveling to Oaks, PA to visit the American Treasure Tour. The American Treasure Tour is an all indoor massive collection of Americana from antiques to kitsch to pop culture. Two of their major exhibits are mechanical music and classic preserved automobiles. The mechanical music display includes hundreds of machines such as nickelodeons, band organs and music boxes. In addition to seeing the sights you will hear the great sounds of the music of days gone by. Additionally, they have a jam packed display of animated store window advertising, dolls, doll houses, model airplanes, circus, patriotic, holiday items and many surprises. Group tours ride the tram to experience the vast collection as well as enjoy a seated presentation in their Music Room. It is always a great day at the American Treasure Tour! Come join the fun! You will be having a 90-minute tour today. After our visit here, we will head back to Lancaster for a special dinner. Dinner tonight is included at a local restaurant. Tasty, authentic Penn Dutch cooking is yours to enjoy. Back to Inn after dinner.

Day Three: Breakfast is included again at the hotel this morning. After breakfast, you will have a local guided tour of the area, as well as visit an Amish School and home. Lunch today will be on your own at the Kitchen Kettle Village with over 40 shops offering homemade Lancaster County food, fresh baked foods and even a horse and buggy ride! After lunch you will travel to the breathtaking Sight & Sound Theatre where you will see an afternoon performance of "JONAH." Jonah is a prophet - and a man on the run. From who? From God! After a series of wild adventures involving a seaport called Joppa, a huge boat and a terrible storm, Jonah finds himself in the belly of a giant fish! But this isn't the end. It's here that God teaches Jonah how to receive grace and extend mercy, even to his archenemy: Nineveh. Take your family deep into this Bible classic as it springs to life on stage in jaw-dropping scale by a world-class cast, spectacular special effects and live animals - on stage and in the aisles.
