On September 11, 2017 at approximately 11:54 PM, the Hudson Police and Hudson Fire Departments responded to a single vehicle accident in the parking lot of 7-Eleven, 230 Central Street, where a vehicle had struck the building. Upon arrival it was determined the vehicle struck the natural gas line, which was attached to the building, causing a gas leak. Hudson Fire was able to shut off the gas.

The vehicle, a 2004 Mercury Minivan, was attempting to park in a parking spot on the side of the building. The vehicle was operated by Mercedes McGlynn, 33 years old, of Hudson, NH. McGlynn was not injured.

McGlynn was subsequently arrested for Driving While Intoxicated. She was released on PR bail and scheduled to be arraigned at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court on September 21, 2017 at 8:15 am.

The vehicle sustained minor damage and was towed from the scene. There was no damage to the building and the gas company secured the leak.
