On October 10, 2017 at approximately 3:30 PM, the Hudson Police and Hudson Fire Departments responded to a three vehicle accident at the intersection of Central St. and Park Ave. Through the initial investigation, it was determined a 2002 Ford Ranger, operated by Joseph ALBINA, 22 years old of Milford, NH was traveling east on Central St. approaching stopped traffic at the intersection of Central St. and Park Ave. ALBINA became distracted and failed to yield to stopped traffic, after which he struck the rear of a 2003 Mitsubishi Eclipse, operated by Pamela DENNY 74, of Hampstead, NH. DENNY's vehicle was pushed forward into another vehicle, a 2010 Honda CRV operated by Claire DUMON of Hudson, NH. DENNY received potentially serious injuries and was flown by helicopter to Mass General Hospital. DUMON received minor injuries and was transported by the Hudson Fire Department to Southern New Hampshire Medical Center for treatment. All vehicles sustained heavy damage. As a result of the seriousness of the accident, the Hudson Crash Investigation Team was activated to investigate the scene; the investigation is ongoing.

ALBINA was cited for Negligent Driving; drugs or alcohol do not appear to be a factor. The area of Central St. and Park Ave. is now clear of vehicles.
