**On July 16, 2017, at about 7:34 PM, members of the Hudson Police Department and Hudson Fire Department responded to Central Street (Route 111) west of Sullivan Road for a single car collision.**

**Upon arrival, members of the Hudson Fire Department and Hudson Police Department attended to the occupants of the involved vehicle. The Hudson Police Department began an investigation. Through the initial investigation, it was determined a 1993 Ford Mustang was traveling west on Central Street approaching Sullivan Road. It was operated by George Degraan, 43 years old, of Nashua, NH. It was also occupied by Melanie Kanarian, 46 years old, of Nashua, NH and Charles Parker, 19 years old of Manchester, NH.**

**The Mustang was approaching a bicyclist in the breakdown lane. The Ford began to drift to the right and then swerved. It went off the paved road and crashed head-on into a large granite boulder. After striking the boulder, the car began to roll over. The front passenger, was ejected from the car before the car came to rest on its wheels. Airbags were deployed in the Ford and it was determined all occupants were not seatbelted or properly restrained. One occupant was transported to the hospital for non-life threatening injuries. The vehicle was towed from the scene with heavy damage.**

**The operator of the Mustang was issued a court summons for Negligent Driving. The crash is still under investigation.**
