On January 25, 2015 at about 4:45 PM, members of the Hudson Police Department and Fire Department responded to the area of 300 Derry Street for the report of a car colliding with a utility pole, and the driver was trapped inside the motor vehicle. Fire and EMT personnel quickly arrived on scene, and within approximately 15 minutes extricated the driver utilizing the Jaws of Life.

The Hudson Police identified the driver as Darwin Zimmerman, 50, of Hudson, New Hampshire. An on-scene investigation determined that Mr. Zimmerman was traveling south on Derry Street when he careened off the roadway, and struck the utility pole along the southbound lane of Derry Street at the entrance of Primary Care of Hudson located at 300 Derry Street.

Mr. Zimmerman was the only occupant in the car, he was not wearing his seatbelt and there was airbag deployment. Zimmerman was transported to the Southern New Hampshire Medical Center, and then airlifted to Massachusetts General Hospital to be treated for serious injuries.

Subsequently, Mr. Zimmerman was charged with driving with a suspended license, and is scheduled to appear at the 9th Circuit Court-Nashua on March 5, 2015. This accident remains under investigation.
