On August 27, 2017, at about 8:18 PM, the Hudson Police and Hudson Fire Departments responded to a single car roll over on Dracut Road near 133 Dracut Rd. Upon arrival, the Hudson Fire Department attended to the lone occupant of the vehicle while the police officers investigated the crash.



It was determined a 1999 Chevrolet Tahoe was traveling north on Dracut Road near 133 Dracut Road. The vehicle went off the road to the right and struck a utility pole. The vehicle rolled over and came to rest on the driver side door. It was operated by Michael St. Onge, 31 years old, of Nashua, NH. He was not seat belted at the time, but was also apparently uninjured.

St. Onge was subsequently arrested for Driving While Intoxicated 2nd Offense. His vehicle was towed from the scene. St. Onge was transported to the Hudson Police Department for booking. His bail was set at \$1000 Personal Recognizance. He is scheduled to appear for arraignment on September 28, 2017 at the 9th Circuit Court - Nashua District Division.

The utility pole sustained damage and Eversource Crews responded to replace the pole. It is likely the road will have a partial closure throughout the evening, but it is not expected to affect the morning commute.
