At about 7:35 pm, Hudson Police Officers responded to the area 35 Dracut Road for a single car accident into a tree. Upon the officers' arrival, they located a 2012 Chrysler 500 driven by Timothy McKinnon, 34, of Merrimack in the yard of 35 Dracut Road. According to witness, McKinnon was traveling north on Dracut Road. In the area of 35 Dracut Road, McKinnon drifted over the southbound lane and into the yard of 35 Dracut Road where he collided with a tree.

Due to McKinnon's injuries, the Hudson Fire Department EMT's requested a DHART helicopter respond to the parking lot of St. Kathryn's Church. McKinnon was then airlifted to Mass General hospital. Currently, McKinnon is listed in serious condition. McKinnon was the lone occupant of the car, there was airbag deployment and it is unknown if he was wearing a seatbelt.

This accident remains under investigation by the Hudson Police Department Accident Reconstruction Team.
