

On Monday May 15th at around 1240 in the afternoon officers from the Hudson Police Department responded to a noise complaint at the Burns Hill Apartments, specifically 1 Burns Hill Road, Apartment 6. Upon arrival officers attempted to make contact with the residents who opened the door initially. Upon seeing it was police officers the people in the apartment slammed the door and began barricading it. Officers outside the door were able to see evidence of drug activity in plain view. The suspects fled out the rear window of the apartment. Officers engaged in a short foot pursuit where one individual was captured. The other individuals (at least two more) were able to make their escape. The other individuals will face charges when they are positively identified. The individual who was caught was identified as:

Or Nigel WOODARD
24 years old
Of
Nashua NH

A large quantity of marijuana was recovered at the scene. The apartment was secured and a search warrant was sought. As of the time of this release the search warrant had not been served. ALMONTE was charged with: Possession of a Controlled Drug with intent to Distribute (within 1000 feet of a school), and 2 counts of Resisting Arrest or Detention. ALMONTE'S bail was set at \$30,000 cash and will be arraigned in the 9th Circuit Court, Nashua tomorrow. The incident took place near the Nottingham West Elementary School which, as a precaution, was put on lockdown until the incident had been resolved. At no time was there any danger to the students at the school.
