On November 2, 2017, at about 11:00 AM, Officer McNally responded to Quail Run for suspicious activity. Through his investigation, he learned a subject who was wanted for Burglary may be in the area. A short time later, Officer McNally observed the wanted subject he knew as John Barbuti, 30 years old, originally of Hudson, NH, on foot in the woods. Barbuti has outstanding Felony warrants from multiple New Hampshire agencies, including Hudson. He is also wanted by the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Department for Non Appearance in Court. Recently, Barbuti had been residing in Florida.

As Officer McNally was attempting to make contact with the subject, Barbuti had fled on foot through the woods. Officer McNally was able to overtake Barbuti in the area of St. Anthony Drive.

Barbuti was arrested and transported to the Hudson Police Department for booking. Barbuti is charged with Burglary that occurred in July 2017 and for Resisting Arrest on today's date. He refused bail, and is scheduled to be arraigned on November 3, 2017 at the 9th Circuit Court- Nashua District Division.
