On April 17, 2016 at approximately 0100 hours, officers from the Hudson Police Department responded to 76 Derry Street, also known as the 102 Plaza, in response to a subject discharging a firearm in the parking lot of the plaza. Upon arrival, the subject involved was identified as Terry Allen, 35 years old of Hudson, NH. An investigation into the incident revealed that Allen and another male subject had become involved in an altercation within a drinking establishment known as Capri Pizza. The altercation continued in the parking lot as both subjects left that location. It was learned that Allen drew a .40 caliber Smith and Wesson semi-automatic and fired three rounds in the air. The firearm was recovered in a wooded area near the 102 Plaza. Allen was taken into custody and charged with Reckless Conduct, a class B felony as well as Criminal Threatening, also a class B felony. Allen was able to post bail and is scheduled to be arraigned in the Nashua 9th Circuit Court on May 19, 2016. This incident remains under investigation.
