On August 17, 2017 at about 3:00pm, the Hudson Police Department responded to the area of Derry Street near Easy Street for a car into a utility pole. The Hudson Fire Department also responded due to reports that the car was on fire. Upon the Hudson Fire Department's arrival, they located a small brush fire under the engine compartment which was quickly extinguished.



The on-scene Hudson Police officers conducted an investigation and learned that Amanda Ayer, 21, of Hudson was traveling north on Derry Street in a 1995 Chevy pickup truck. In the area just north of Easy Street, Ayer veered off the roadway and struck a utility pole along the shoulder of the northbound lane of Derry Street.

Ayer was alone in the vehicle at the time of the accident, she was wearing her seatbelt, the airbags deployed and she was not injured. Subsequently, Ayer was arrested for DWI/Drugs and Use of Electronic Mobile Devices. Ayer was released on personal recognizance bail and is scheduled for arraignment on September 14, 2017 at the 9th Circuit Court in Nashua

As of this writing, Derry Street between Elm Ave. and Derry Lane is closed while crews work to repair the damaged utility pole. There are residence in the area without power.
