Chief Lavoie would like to announce, a team of assessors from the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA) will arrive December 4, 2017 to examine all aspects of the Hudson Police Department's policies and procedures, management, operations and support services.

Verification by the team that the Hudson Police Department meets the Commission's state-of-the-art standards is part of a voluntary process to gain re-accreditation after having received the initial National Accreditation in March of 2003, and having been subsequently re-accredited in March of 2006, 2009, 2012 and 2015.

The assessors will review written materials, interview individuals, and visit offices and other places where compliance can be witnessed. The assessors are: Team Leader-Chief Michael Yaniero, Jacksonville (NC) Police Department, and Major Traci Estep, Lee County (FL) Sheriff's Office.

Once the Commission's Assessors complete their review of the Hudson Police Department, they report back to the full Commission, which will then decide if the agency is to be granted re-accreditation status.

As part of the on site assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session on December 5, 2017 at 5:00 PM. The session will be conducted in the Buxton Room of the Hudson Town Hall located at 12 School Street, Hudson.

Agency employees and the public are also invited to offer comments by calling (603) 816-2247 on December 5, 2017, between the hours of 1:00 PM and 3:00 PM. Comments will be taken by the Assessment Team.

On December 6, 2017 at 2:00 PM as part of our CALEA assessment, members of our Assessment Team, Hudson Police Department Command Staff and Town of Hudson Officials will be available to members of the media for questions and photographs.
