At about 4:40 pm, Hudson Police Officers responded to a residence on Old Derry Road for a domestic disturbance between live-in boyfriend and girlfriend. The boyfriend was later identified as Michael Casaletto, 29, of Hudson. While officers were enroute, the female alleged that Casaletto had assaulted her and fled into a wooded area behind the house. Additionally, the female advised that Casaletto was armed with a holstered sidearm, and was in the company of his five year old son. The responding officers quickly set up a perimeter around the property and wooded area. A Nashua K-9 officer, as well as several Nashua Police Officers responded to assist. At about 5:40 pm, Casaletto walked out of the wooded area with his son and surrendered to police without incident. Casaletto's sidearm was still holstered. Casaletto was then taken into custody for two counts of Domestic Violence Simple Assault. The five year old was not harmed, and he was released to a guardian.

No one was injured during this incident.

Casaletto was released on \$5750.00 Personal Recognizance and Cash bail. He is scheduled to for arraignment on October 30, 2017 at the 9th Circuit Court in Nashua.
