On October 16, 2015 at about 7:00 pm, members of the Hudson Police and Hudson Fire Departments responded to the area of 196 Central Street for a reported motor vehicle accident involving a pedestrian. Upon the officers arrival they determined that Nicholas Cadieux, 23, of Londonderry, NH was operating a 2002 Chevy Silverado and traveling west on Central Street. In the area of 196 Central Street, Michael Letares, 49, of Hudson, NH walked north across Central Street and into Mr. Cadieux's travel lane where they collided. Subsequently, Mr. Letares was transported by the Hudson Fire Department EMT's to the SNHRMC for minor non-life threatening injuries.

At the time of the accident, Mr. Letares was not in a crosswalk and was several feet from the intersection with Burnham Road, and Mr. Cadieux was wearing his seatbelt, there was no airbag deployment and he was the lone occupant of the vehicle.

This accident remains under investigation by the Hudson Police Department.
