Greetings,

On February 1, 2018, at approximately 2350 hours, members of the Hudson Police Department's Patrol Division responded to Cumberland Farms, located at 189 Central Street, for a report of credit card fraud. The suspects who were later identified as Justin Foe (22) of New York, NY, and Taylon Hill (19) of Westbury, NY. Foe and Hill entered the store and made a couple small purchases with a credit card. The two then attempted to purchase over \$100 in cigarettes with the same credit card. The clerk subsequently requested identification for the transaction. Noting discrepancies with the identification and credit card, the clerk cancelled the transaction and called the police.

Members of the Hudson Police patrol division were able to locate and stop the suspects in a 2017, Silver Volkswagen Jetta, bearing a Connecticut Registration. Justin Foe and Taylon Hill were within the vehicle along with three other subjects. During the investigation, it was learned one of the driver: Deval Rhodes (26) of New York, NY was also involved in this incident.

Justin Foe, Deval Rhodes and Taylon Hill were subsequently arrested. Deval Rhodes was charged with one count of Identity Fraud, a Class A Felony. Justin Foe was charged with eight counts of Identity Fraud, all Class A Felonies, and one count of Credit Card Fraud, a Class A Misdemeanor. Taylon Hill was charged with one count of Credit Card Fraud, a Class A Misdemeanor. Deval Rhodes and Justin Foe are to be arraigned at the 9th Circuit Superior Court on February 2, 2018, at 1300 hours. Taylon Hill is to be arraigned at the 9th Circuit District Court on February 2, 2018, at 0815 hours.
