On December 15, 2015 at 5:20 PM, members of the Hudson Police and Fire Departments responded to the parking lot of Dunkin' Donuts, located at 86 Derry Street, for a reported motor vehicle accident involving a pedestrian. Upon the officers' arrival, they determined that Pamela Stultz, 59, of Hudson, NH was walking through the parking lot of Dunkin' Donuts when she was struck by a 2004 Dodge Durango driven by Scott Murphy, 46, of Hudson, NH.

Subsequently, Ms. Stutz was transported to the SNRMC by the Hudson Fire Department, then later she was transferred to the Massachusetts General Hospital for potentially serious but non-life threatening injuries. Mr. Murphy was not injured, he was wearing a seatbelt, there was no airbag deployment and he was the lone occupant of the vehicle.

Drugs, alcohol and speed do not appear to be factors in the accident. This collision remains under investigation by the Hudson Police Department Accident Reconstruction Team.
