On October 18th at around 907 a.m. the Hudson Fire Department and Police Department responded to the intersection of Derry Street (Route 102) and the Hudson Mall for a report of a three car crash. Upon arrival it was discovered through witnesses that a 1996 Volvo sedan driven by

Had been traveling north at a high rate of speed in the right turn lane in front of the Hudson Mall. The Volvo ran through a red traffic signal where it was struck in the right side by a 2003 Chevy Pickup driven by:

Robert Coburn  
59 years old  
Of Nashua NH

The Chevy had received a green light and started to turn left onto Derry Street from the Hudson Mall when the Volvo came through the intersection. The Volvo then spun out of control and struck a 2011 Jeep Grand Cherokee that was stopped at the traffic light in the south bound lane of Derry Street. The Jeep was driven by:

Miladys Bowman  
60 years old  
Of Londonderry NH

Both Carter and Bowman were transported to Southern New Hampshire Medical Center by the Hudson Fire ambulance and an AMR Ambulance for evaluation of minor injuries. The Jeep and Volvo had to be towed from the scene. Traffic was impacted for about an hour while the police investigated the crash and had the vehicles removed from the roadway. Charges are pending in this case.
