On November 16, 2017 at about 4:51 pm, members of the Hudson Police Department responded to the area of 334 Derry Road for a report of a missing person. It was reported that the missing subject was last heard from at 3:35 PM, by family members. The subject's cellular phone was indicating she was located in the area of 334 Derry Road. The missing person was identified as Susan Jozokos of Pelham, New Hampshire.

A search of the area commenced, utilizing a thermal imaging device along with several officers. Mutual aid was utilized as the Nashua Police K-9 was called to the scene as well. Prior to the Nashua Police K-9's arrival, Susan Jozokos and her vehicle were located in ravine adjacent to Derry Road and Rymes Propane and Oil.

It was learned that Susan Jozokos was involved in a single vehicle motor vehicle collision. She was operating a 2006 Ford Expedition, in the parking lot of Rymes Propane and Oil, when her vehicle left the roadway and travelled into a ravine.

Susan Jozokos was transported to the Southern New Hampshire Medical Center for treatment. She was subsequently moved to the Massachusetts General Hospital for further medical care. The crash is still under investigation and anyone with any information is urged to contact the Shift Commander or Shift Supervisor at 603-886-6011.
