On Saturday, September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2015, from 10:00AM to 2:00PM, the Hudson Police Department will be at the Hudson Wal-Mart (customer service area) located at 254 Lowell Road (Rte. 3A), collecting any unused, unwanted and/or expired prescription drugs for safe disposal. There is no cost for this service and there are no questions asked. This is an opportunity to safely empty out your medicine cabinet of expired prescription drugs or drugs you do not need anymore. Needles will not be accepted.

The Prescription Drug Take-Back Program is a Nationwide event sponsored by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration. The DEA and partner organizations, such as the Hudson Police Department, will set up sites in communities around the country where the public can bring unused, unwanted and/or expired prescription drugs for safe disposal.
