On 07/12/2017 at approximately 09:32 the Hudson Police Department responded the Michael Steven residence located at 82 Ferry ST for a report of a suspicious package. Upon arrival Officers found a small cylindrical package located on the front yard near the street. The residents told the responding Officer that it had not been there the night before and they saw it there this morning. The residents had also reported that they had a few instances of criminal mischief in the past.
