On April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017, at about 3:17 PM, the Hudson Police Department responded to Dunkin Donuts, 223 Lowell Road for the report of a pedestrian collision. Upon arrival, it was determined the collision took place on Flagstone Drive near Hampshire Drive, however, all parties involved were at 223 Lowell Road.



Through the investigation, it was determined the collision took place in the area of 21 and 16 Flagstone Drive. The pedestrian was identified as Trevor Walford, 33 years old, of Hudson, NH. He was moving east on Flagstone Drive, crossing the road where no crosswalks exist. The road bends at that location and the closest intersection would be at Hampshire Drive, about 175 feet to the north east.

Sadie Creighton, 28 years old, of Nashua, NH was operating north east on Flagstone Drive, approaching Hampshire Drive in the area of 21 and 16 Flagstone Drive in a 2002, GMC Safari Van.

As Walford continued across the street, the GMC struck Walford who came to a rest on the lawn of 16 Hampshire Drive. Walford was assisted into the van by Creighton where they traveled to 223 Lowell Road.

Walford was attended to on scene by Hudson Fire Department members. He was subsequently transported to Southern New Hampshire Medical Center for his injuries.



**He was later transported to Massachusetts General Hospital for serious, but apparently non-life threatening injuries.**

**Creighton was arrested on scene for Operating After Suspension, 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense. She was later booked and processed at the Hudson Police Department. She was released on Personal Recognizance bail and schedule to appear at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court - Nashua District Division on May 11, 2017 at 8:15 AM. The vehicle she was operating was towed from 223 Lowell Road with moderate front end damage and windshield damage.**
