**On December 6, 2015, at about 3:11 PM, members of the Hudson Fire Department and Hudson Police Department responded to Highland Street near 83 Highland Street for a report of a single motor vehicle collision with a pedestrian.**

**Upon arrival, members of the Hudson Fire Department attended to the pedestrian and occupants of the vehicle. The Hudson Police Department began an investigation into the crash. During the initial stages of the investigation, it was determined a 2007 Hyundai Tucson was traveling west on Highland Street, west of the intersection of George Street. The vehicle was operated by Scott Hicks, 49 years old of Hudson, NH. It was also occupied by Cynthia Hicks, 46 years old of Hudson, NH, and their 16 year old son.**

**A 14 year old Hudson resident was crossing the street, north bound, on foot, in the area of 83 Highland Street. The vehicle and the pedestrian collided. The pedestrian was treated on scene for possible life threatening injuries. He was transported to the parking lot of HO Smith School by the Hudson Fire Department. There, he was med-flighted to Massachusetts General Hospital.**

**The occupants of the Hyundai were all uninjured. Members of The Hudson Police Crash Investigation and Reconstruction Team were called out to further investigate. The cause of the collision is still under investigation. Alcohol does not appear to be a factor.**

**The road was closed from George Street to Gloria Avenue. Since the time of this release, the road has been reopened for traffic.**
