On July 20, 2017, at about 3:47 PM, Master Patrol Officer Brian Morgan attempted to stop a 2001 Toyota 4Runner in the area of Belknap Road. The operator was known to the officer to have an active warrant out of Merrimack, NH. The operator was identified as Kurt Hans Hovling, 43 years old of Hudson, NH.

The Toyota sped off at a high rate of speed as the officer tried to stop him. Officer Morgan pursued the vehicle on Belknap Road to Melendy Road, where the vehicle turned onto Pelham Road towards Bush Hill Road and continued trying to elude the officer. Once on Bush Hill Road, the Toyota traveled towards Pelham, but turned onto Moose Hill Road, a cul de sac. The Toyota traveled off road and into shallow basin where it came to a stop. Hovling exited the vehicle and began to flee on foot. Officer Morgan was able to give chase to Hovling and apprehend him.

Hovling was charged with Reckless Conduct (Felony), Disobeying a Police Officer (Class A Misdemeanor), Resisting Arrest (Class A Misdemeanor), Driving after Suspension (Class A Misdemeanor). Hovling refused the services of a Bail Commissioner and was transported to Valley Street Jail to await arraignment at the 9th Circuit Court - Nashua District Division on July 21, 2017.
