On July 29, 2017 at approximately 1:30 am Hudson Police arrested:

Lenell Lopez

33 years old of Nashua, NH

The officer attempted to stop a vehicle on Ferry Street for speed. The vehicle attempted to elude the officer and struck a tree at the intersection of Library Street and Ferry Street. The driver, was identified as Lopez, fled the scene on foot toward Nashua. MPO Connor and his K-9 Looch were on scene and tracked Lopez to the Merrimack River. Lopez jumped into the Merrimack River to avoid apprehension and began floating downstream. Lopez began struggling in the water and the Hudson Fire Department was contacted. Hudson Fire deployed a boat and rescued Lopez. He was brought the Nashua side of the River where he was taken into custody.

Lopez was transported to SNHMC for evaluation by AMR Ambulance. Lopez was treated and released from the hospital. Lopez was transported back the the Hudson Police Department where he refused bail. Lopez was taken to Valley Street Jail pending his arraignment on Monday, July 31, 2017. Lopez's charges include Disobeying a Police Officer, Conduct After an Accident, Resisting Arrest, Possession of Drugs, Driving After Suspension, Driving Without Proof of Financial Responsibility, and Speeding.
