On Tuesday, June 30, 2015, Edmund Masse, 36 years old of Hudson, New Hampshire, was arrested on an active Hudson Police Department arrest warrant. Masse is being charged with two (2) counts of Certain Uses of a Computer Prohibited, both charges are Class B Felonies.

Masse's arrest is the culmination of a several month long multi-agency investigation involving the Hudson Police Criminal Investigations Division, the New Hampshire and New York Internet Crimes Against Children Task Forces, along with the FBI's Safe Streets Task Force.



Masse was booked at the Hudson Police Department for the above-listed charges, where he refused bail. Masse is currently being held at the Valley Street Jail in Manchester, pending his arraignment on Wednesday, July 1, 2015. The investigation is ongoing and additional charges may be forthcoming.
