On October 22, 2015 at about 3:45 pm, members of the Hudson Police and Fire Departments responded to the area of Lowell Road by Haffner's Gas Station, located at 215 Lowell Road for a motor vehicle accident. Upon the officers' arrival, they determined that Amy Gagnon, 36, of Hudson was operating a 2014 Mazda CX9. Gagnon was traveling north on Lowell Road and making a left turn into the Haffner's Gas Station. At the same time, Bryan Jette, 57, of Nashua was operating a 1996 Yamaha motorcycle and traveling south on Lowell Road near Haffner's Gas Station. Gagnon crossed into Jette's travel lane and the two vehicles collided. Subsequently, Jette was transported by the Hudson Fire Department EMT's to the SNHRMC for minor non-life threatening injuries.

Gagnon was wearing a seat belt, she was the lone occupant of the vehicle, there was no airbag deployment and she was not injured. Jette was the lone occupant of the motorcycle, and at this time it is unclear whether Jette was wearing a helmet.

Portions of Lowell Road, in the area of Haffner's Gas Station, were closed while the Hudson police conducted an investigation. Currently, this accident remains under investigation by the Hudson Police Department.
