On December 26, 2015 at 8:20PM, members of the Hudson Police and Fire Departments responded to the area of Robinson Road near Old Derry Road for a single vehicle accident involving a motorcycle. Upon arrival, the officers identified the motorcycle driver as Kevin Meaney, 56, of Hudson, NH. Mr. Meaney was operating a 2012 Harley Davidson motorcycle. Officers conducted an on-scene accident and determined that Mr. Meaney was driving east on Robinson Road when he left the roadway just east of Old Derry Road. It appears that Mr. Meaney struck a utility pole off the shoulder of the road before traveling into a wooded area.

Mr. Meaney was transported by Hudson Fire EMT's to the Hills House on Derry Road, where he was then flown by a medical helicopter to Mass General Hospital in Boston, MA for serious life threatening injuries.

Mr. Meaney was the lone occupant of the motorcycle and he was not wearing a helmet.

This accident is under investigation by the Hudson Police Department Accident Reconstruction Team.
