On November 18, 2016 at approximately 1:40 a.m. members of the Hudson Police Department and Hudson Fire Department responded to a motor vehicle collision in the area of Wason Road. Upon arrival it was learned that a blue 2006 Ford F350 pickup truck had been traveling east on Wason Road prior to the collision. The vehicle went off the road way into the west bound lane and struck a telephone pole. There was heavy front end and passenger side damage to the vehicle. The driver, who was identified as Dylan Conroy, 22 years old of Hudson, N.H. was able to exit the vehicle and asked for assistance from an individual at a nearby residence. Conroy was taken into custody and was charged with Driving While Intoxicated. Conroy was transported to the Southern New Hampshire Medical Center to be evaluated. Conroy was released on personal recognizance bail on this date. Conroy is scheduled to appear in the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court on December 1, 2016 for arraignment. Crew members from Eversource responded to the scene to evaluate the damage to the telephone pole which at this time is not creating a traffic hazard to commuters. The collision remains under investigation.
