On November 17, 2016 members of the Hudson Police Department and Hudson Fire Department responded to a motor vehicle collision in the area of Elm Avenue and Webster Street. Upon arrival it was learned that a white 2014 Volkswagen Jetta had been traveling north on Webster Street prior to the collision. The vehicle travelled through a stop sign at the intersection of Webster Street and Elm Ave and struck a telephone pole directly across the street at this intersection. The impact of the collision caused the vehicle to flip and come to a rest on its passenger side. The driver, who was identified as Daniel Martinage, 22 years old of Hudson, N.H. was able to exit the vehicle without apparent injury. Martinage was taken into custody and was charged with Driving While Intoxicated. Martinage was booked, processed and released on personal recognizance on this date. Martinage is scheduled to appear in the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court on December 1, 2016 for arraignment. Crew members from Eversource, Liberty Utilities and Pennichuck responded to evaluate the damage to the pole. The collision remains under investigation as of this writing.
