On Monday, August 21, 2017 at approximately 10:30 PM, the Hudson Police Department and the Hudson Fire Department responded to Kimball Hill Road and Clement Road for a report of a collision involving a motorcycle and a vehicle. Upon arrival members of the Hudson Police and Hudson Fire Departments attended to the injured motorcyclist and the operator of the other vehicle.

During the course of the investigation it was determined a 2005 Harley Davidson FLSTF was traveling South on Clement Road. The Harley Davidson was operated by Thomas Ellis, 58 years old, of Billerica, MA. A 2008 Ford Explorer was traveling East on Kimball Hill Road. The Explorer was operated by Dante Lonardo, 18 years old, of Hudson, NH. The Harley Davidson turned from Clement Road onto Kimball Hill Road in front of the Explorer and the 2 vehicles collided.

Due to the potential life threatening, serious injuries sustained to Ellis, the Hudson Fire Department coordinated a med-flight, and Ellis was air lifted to Massachusetts General Hospital for treatment. Ellis was not wearing a helmet at the time of the collision.

Lonardo was wearing a seatbelt and was not injured.

The Explorer sustained moderate damage and was driven from the scene. The motorcycle sustained heavy damage and was towed from the scene. The roadway was closed for approximately 30 minutes.

The cause of the crash is still under investigation
