On July 29, 2017, at about 7:49 PM, Hudson Police and Hudson Fire personnel responded to Robinson Road at Henry Drive for a report of a motor vehicle collision involving a motor cycle.

Hudson Fire Department members immediately attended to the operator of the motorcycle. Members of the Hudson Police Department, through the course of the investigation, determined a 1998 Honda Civic driven by Brandon Greenhalgh, 18 years old of Hudson, NH, was traveling north on Henry Drive approaching the intersection of Robinson Road. Henry Drive has a stop sign at that intersection.

At the same time, Bradley Loeb, 27 years old, of Litchfield, NH, was traveling east on Robinson Road approaching Henry Drive. He was operating a 2011 Kawasaki Ninja and wearing a helmet.

The Honda began to take a right turn onto Robinson Road and the two vehicles collided. Greenhalgh was uninjured at the time. Loeb was transported to Southern New Hampshire Medical Center for potentially serious, but non-lifethreatening injuries.

The Honda sustained moderate to heavy front end damage. The Kawasaki also sustained moderate to heavy damage. Both vehicles were towed from the scene. The cause of the crash is under investigation. Alcohol and speed do not appear to be factors in the crash.
