On February 16, 2017, at about 9:22 PM, The Hudson Police Department responded to 53 Mobile Drive for a domestic disturbance. The owner of the residence had advised her son was out of control and may be damaging the home. Upon arrival on scene, officers observed the trailer home filling with black smoke. Officers banged on the door and eventually a male party answered. He was identified as Bryan Huntress, 29 years old. He was evacuated from the building. The owner was located away from the trailer and safe. Officers alerted nearby trailer residents as well to evacuate.

The Hudson Fire Department responded and put down the fire. Members of the Hudson Fire Department and Hudson Police Department began a joint investigation of the incident and cause of the fire.

Bryan Huntress was subsequently arrested for Arson by the Hudson Police. He was transported to the Hudson Police Department for booking. His bail was set at \$25,000 Cash. He was transported to Valley Street Jail to await arraignment on February 17, 2017 at the 9th Circuit Court - Nashua District Division.
