On Friday, June 16, 2015, Louis Pilat (18 years old) of Hudson, NH turned himself in on an active Hudson Police Department arrest warrant. Pilat is being charged with four counts of Distribution of Child Pornography, one count of Manufacturing of Child Pornography, one count of Possession of Child Pornography, and one count of Certain Uses of Computer Services Prohibited. All charges are Class A Felonies.



Pilat's arrest is the culmination of a month long Hudson Police investigation. The Hudson Police Criminal Investigative Division began its investigation after the receipt of several tips involving the uploading of contraband images to public internet servers. Hudson PD was assisted with this investigation by New Hampshire Internet Crimes Against Children Taskforce members from the Portsmouth PD, Bedford PD, Salem PD, Manchester PD, Derry PD, Amherst PD, Nashua PD, and US Homeland Security Investigations. The investigation is ongoing, but at this time it appears that no children from the local area are involved.

Pilat was released on \$50,000 personal recognizance bail and will be arraigned at the Nashua 9th Circuit Court on August 6, 2015.
