On February 26, 2016, the Hudson Police Department initiated an investigation into a theft at Service Credit Union, 254 Lowell Road. The Hudson Police Department is seeking to identify the suspect in this theft. The theft involved a solo distraction scam where the unknown female suspect requested her money exchanged from fifty dollar bills to one hundred dollar bills. The suspected continued to distract the cashier with conversation, then advised she actually wanted the bills converted to \$20 bills. During the course of this transaction the suspect was able to use distraction and deception to steal a few hundred dollars. The Hudson Police Department is now in receipt of still images from video surveillance and are requesting assistance from the public to identify the female subject involved. The suspect appears proficient in her scam. It is possible the subject may repeat this scam again. Area businesses are encouraged to be vigilant to this type of crime and report any similar activity.
