On April 11, 2016, at about 8:56 PM, the Hudson Police and Hudson Fire Departments responded to Goodwill, 9 Wason Road, Hudson, for a possible explosive device located there. It was about closing and only employees were left on scene. The store was evacuated.

Upon initial investigation, it was determined an employee located, what appeared to be a grenade, in a box of goods donated to the store. The Nashua Bomb Squad responded at the request of the Hudson Police Department. The Nashua Bomb Squad was able to remove a hollowed out grenade. There were no explosives within the object. Employees were allowed back into the store.

At this time, the Hudson Police Department has not identified who donated the box of goods. The incident is under investigation.
