On May 10, 2016 at 3:00 PM, the Hudson Police Department responded to the Citizens Bank, located at 71 Lowell Road for a reported bank robbery. Upon the officers' arrival, they learned from bank personnel that the suspect fled on foot with an undetermined amount of cash. The suspect is described as a white male, about 20 to 30 years of age, wearing a baseball cap, a grey t-shirt with a logo and blue jeans. At this time it is unclear if the male suspect displayed any sort of weapon.

Currently, the Citizens Bank is closed while members of the Hudson Police Department Criminal Investigation Division and Crime Scene Unit conduct their investigation. Also, Hudson Police Department officers, along with officers from surrounding towns are canvassing the neighborhoods near the bank.

The Hudson Police Department is asking that residents use caution should they observe a suspicious subject in their neighborhood, and contact the police immediately.

*****UPDATE*****

On May 10, 2016 at 5:00 PM, officers of the Hudson Police Department responded to the 300 block of Fox Hollow Drive based on witnesses calling the police department to report a male subject matching the description of the bank robbery suspect. Officers arriving to the area located the male subject and engaged in a foot pursuit. However, the officers overcame the male subject and took him into custody. He was identified as John Stocki, 26, of Lexington, MA. Stocki was charged with unarmed Robbery (class A Felony) and Resisting Arrest (class A Misdemeanor). Bail was set at \$100,000.00 cash or surety bail. Stocki will be arraigned at the 9th Circuit Court - Nashua Division on May 11, 2016.
