On June 2, 2016, at about 6:05 PM, Hudson Police Officers were made aware by Londonderry Police of a Robbery that occurred at Citizens Bank in Londonderry, NH. Londonderry Police continued to furnish additional information and images of the male suspect and a vehicle likely involved in the crime. The vehicle was described as a Volvo. Images of that vehicle were provided to the Hudson Officers by Londonderry PD.

At around 6:45 PM, Officer Nathan Glowacki observed a vehicle matching the description on Route 111 in Hudson. The officer attempted to stop the vehicle, however it fled from the area on Ferry Street. A pursuit of the suspect vehicle in Hudson ensued. The vehicle traveled throughout town, disregarding the rules of the road and at high rates of speed. The vehicle eventually traveled on Kimball Hill Road into Pelham, NH onto Keyes Hill Road. The Pelham Police Department was notified. Due to the nature of the crime, the Hudson Police continued in pursuit. The suspect vehicle came to a stop at Talent Road in Pelham, NH. (It was later determined he likely stopped due to mechanical issues). The suspect was taken into custody by the Hudson Police Department with Pelham Police assisting. The suspect was identified as:

Michael Pattelena, 19 years old, of Hollis, NH.

He is charged by the Hudson Police with Reckless Conduct (Felony), Disobeying a Police Officer (Class A Misdemeanor), and Reckless Operation (Violation). Pattelena declined bail and is scheduled to be arraigned at the 9th Circuit Court, Nashua District Division on the morning of June 3, 2016.
