On May 11, 2016, at about 5:03 PM, the Hudson Police Department was advised by NH State Police that they were actively involved in a pursuit traveling north on Lowell Road in Hudson, NH. State Police were in pursuit of a Chevrolet Silverado which was not stopping. The Hudson Police Department was advised the driver had Felony warrants out of Massachusetts.

The suspect continued to evade arrest while traveling at high rates of speed through several streets during busy commute time. The vehicle was traveling east on School Street when it collided briefly with a Massachusetts State Police cruiser, also involved in the pursuit. The Silverado left the pavement on the north edge of School Street and struck a utility pole with its front right corner. After striking the pole, the suspect continued to evade arrest, east on School Street. The vehicle was traveling with at least one flat tire. It eventually traveled west into Nashua over the Veterans Bridge.

The Hudson Police Department was briefly engaged in the pursuit as backup in Hudson only. When the pursuit entered Nashua, the Hudson Police were no longer engaged and did not continue. The Hudson Police shut down School Street from Library Street to Chase Street so the heavy damage to the pole could be assessed and repaired. The road was eventually reopened to the public.

During the course of the Hudson Police investigation, it was determined the suspect vehicle was a 2006 Chevrolet Silverado. It was operated by Richard Simone, 50 years of age, of Worcester, MA. The Hudson Police Department is continuing to investigate this incident and will likely be seeking a warrant for the arrest of Simone.
