The Hudson Police Department arrested Robert Rando (63) and his wife Pauline Rando (60), both of Hudson. The arrests stem from a three month long investigation conducted by the Criminal Investigation Division. The investigation was centered around the suspected overdose death of the Rando's son, Bryan Rando, age 31. Through the investigation it was learned that both Robert Rando and Pauline Rando withheld and tampered with evidence. Both Robert and Pauline Rando are charged with Falsifying Physical Evidence, a Class B Felony and Obstructing Government Administration, a Class A Misdemeanor.

Robert Rando and Pauline Rando's bail was set at \$13,000.00 personal recognizance each. They were released with a court date of February 8, 2018, at the 9th Circuit Court in Nahsua. Class B felonies can be punished with a minimum of 3 ½ years, up to a maximum of 7 years in prison. In addition, these charges carry fines up to \$2,000.
