On 12/26/17 at about 3:30 pm, officers responded to the area of Central Street and Hurley Street for a disturbance. While investigating the incident, an officer attempted to make contact with a suspect in the disturbance who was driving a van that was parked on Hurley Street. While an officer stood near the van in an attempt to speak with the driver, he sped away onto Central Street. The male driver then stopped the van several feet from the intersection with Library Street, and he refused to open the vehicle door or roll down the window. The officers were able to make entry into the van after breaking a window on the vehicle. After a short struggle, the officers took the male subject into custody. The male subject was identified as Joseph Reis, 51, of Nashua, NH.

Reis was charged with Obedience to a Police Officer (violation), Obstructing Government Administration, Reckless Conduct, 2 counts of Resisting Detention, 1 count of Resisting Arrest, Disobeying an Officer and Possession of Marijuana (less than <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> oz.). Reis is being held on \$5,000.00 cash only bail, and he is scheduled to appear at the 9th Circuit Court in Nashua on 12/27/17 at 8:15am.
