On Saturday May 14th at around 0845 a.m. The Hudson Police and Fire Departments responded to the intersection of Route 102 and Tracy lane for a report of a two vehicle crash with injuries. Upon arrival it was discovered that a 2002 Chevrolet Trailblazer driven by a 17 year old Hudson resident was attempting to enter Route 102 from Tracy Lane. When she entered the intersection a 2011 Chevrolet 2500 pickup driven by a 54 year old from Londonderry that was traveling southbound on Route 102 collided with the Trailblazer. The 17 year old was transported to Southern New Hampshire Medical Center for evaluation. The Londonderry resident had non-incapacitating lower leg injuries and did not go to the hospital. The 17 year old was charged with failure to yield. Traffic in the area of the crash was impacted for approximately two hours until the involved vehicles were removed. The road was not closed; however traffic was slowed to a crawl through the scene.
