On November 18, 2017, at about 12:57 AM, Officers responded to the area of Ferry Street by Campbell Avenue for the report of a single vehicle collision into a utility pole. Officers investigated the crash and determined a 2016 Dodge Ram Pick Up was traveling east over the Taylor Falls Bridge into Hudson, NH. The vehicle then went off the road striking a median, a light pole, traffic signs, and a utility pole. The light pole and traffic signs were knocked down from the collision.

It was determined the vehicle was driven by Derek Tomes, 28 years old, of Windham, NH. Tomes was the only occupant. He was treated at the scene by Hudson Fire Department members. Tomes was transported to the SNHMC for further evaluation on non-life threatening injuries. He was arrested for DWI. He is scheduled to appear for arraignment at the 9th Circuit Court, Nashua District Division on November 30, 2017.

The vehicle was towed from the scene with air bag deployment and heavy damage. Eversource was called out to assess the utility pole. Hudson Department of Public Works were called out to remove a large amount of debris from the road. Traffic was detoured for a little over an hour until the road was clear at about 2:30 AM.
