On Friday, September 2, 2016 at approximately 12:29 PM, Hudson Police personnel responded to the intersection of Route 111 and Sullivan Road for the report of a motorcycle vs. car collision. Upon arrival to the scene, it was determined the collision occurred between a subject operating a 2015 Harley Davidson motorcycle identified as follows:

**Kevin Thompson
60-Years-Old
Hudson, New Hampshire**

and a subject operating a 2011 Ford Fiesta identified as follows:

**Charlene Oakley
42-Years-Old
Hudson, New Hampshire**

Preliminary investigation at the scene determined Thompson was operating West on Route 111 when Oakley pulled out from Lawrence Road to make a left hand turn onto Route 111. The collision occurred in the middle of the intersection. Thompson was wearing a helmet, however, he was ejected from the motorcycle suffered serious injuries. He was med-flighted from the scene to a Boston area hospital. Oakley was wearing a seatbelt and suffered minor to moderate injuries from the collision and airbag deployment. She was transported to the Southern New Hampshire Medical Center by the Hudson Fire Ambulance for treatment.

This accident is still under investigation by the Hudson Police Collision Reconstruction Team.
