On January 29, 2018 at about 2:30 PM, members of the Hudson Police Department and Hudson Fire Department responded to 182 Central Street for the report of a single motor vehicle collision involving a school bus. Upon the officers arrival it was determined that the driver of the school bus, Dorothy Noury, of Londonderry, New Hampshire, was operating a Town Of Hudson school bus.

An on scene investigation determined that Noury was traveling east on Central Street when a student(s) became disruptive. Noury pulled the school bus into the parking lot of 182 Central Street so she could turn around and return to Memorial School. While making a three point turn in the parking lot Noury struck 182 Central Street, Hudson Endodontics, causing minor damage to the building and the bus.

The students on the bus were transferred to another bus and transported home. The parents of the students were notified of the accident by the Hudson School District. There were NO injuries and the school bus left the scene under its own power.

There are no charges forthcoming at this time.
