On March 18, 2016, the Hudson Police Department initiated an investigation of Forgery and Identity Theft that occurred at St. Mary's Bank locations in Hudson and Manchester. On March 16, 2016, two female subjects in a white SUV made a transaction at the St. Mary Bank drive through in Hudson. Later, on the same day, the pair made several transactions at the St. Mary's Bank drive through located at 234 Elm Ave. in Manchester. A short time later, the females made a transaction at the St. Mary's Bank drive through branch at 200 McGregor Street in Manchester. When the women attempted to make another transaction, the clerk became suspicious; this caused the female suspects to flee the area. At this time, the bank estimates a loss of over \$5000.00.
