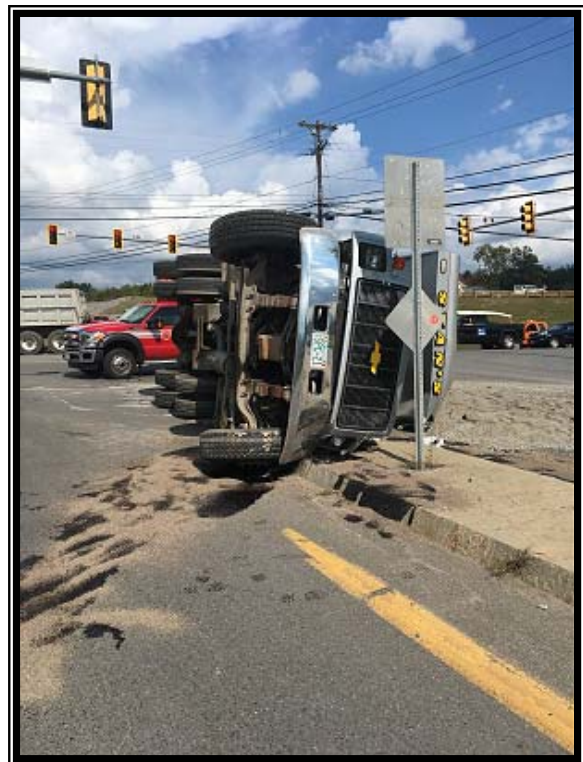

On September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at approximately 2:23 PM, the Hudson Police and Hudson Fire Departments responded to a single commercial vehicle accident at the intersection of Derry Street (Route 102) and Robinson Road, where a commercial dump truck had tipped over, spilling a large load of non-hazardous material onto the roadway. Upon arrival it was determined the vehicle made a right turn from West Road onto Derry Street.

The vehicle, a 1995 Chevrolet Medium Duty dumptruck, made the right turn and the truck rolled onto the driver's side before coming to a stop. The vehicle was operated by Geroge Stanley, 43 years old, of Hudson, NH. Stanley was transported to SNHMC where he was treated for a minor non-life threatening injury.



Stanley was subsequently arrested for Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated. He was released on PR bail and scheduled to be arraigned at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court on September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 8:15 am.

The vehicle sustained heavy damage and was towed from the scene. The area of Derry Street was partially closed momentarily. Workers from Continental Paving Inc., responded to the scene instantaneously and were instrumental in clearing the roadway as quickly as possible in order to re-open the road for the evening commute.
