On Friday, June 19, 2015 at approximately 12:26 PM, Hudson Police patrol personnel responded to the business of America's Pets located at #142 Lowell Road (Nottingham Plaza) for the report of a suspicious package. Upon arrival to the scene, it was determined a citizen found a suspicious package and placed it on the sidewalk of the plaza. Patrol units were unable to determine if the package was safe, therefore, the decision was made to contact the Nashua Police Department to request the assistance of their Hazardous Device Unit.

The Nashua Police Department's Hazardous Device Unit arrived on scene at approximately 1:51 PM. After approximately forty minutes, they were able to determine the package was safe (not of a criminal nature) and cleared the scene without incident. No charges are forthcoming by the Hudson Police Department.
