On 08/06/2016 at approximately 09:03 the Hudson Police Dispatch center received a panic alarm activation from the Hudson Branch of TD Bank North located at 80 Derry St, Hudson NH. The Police Dispatchers were able to confirm through TD Bank North Employees on scene that they had just been robbed.

The first Officer arrived on scene at approximately 09:05 and was able to immediately get a description of the suspect involved to the responding officers. A police K9 was activated and attempted a track. The police K9 followed a scent for a short distance and lost the trail in the area of Abbott Farms condominiums. Upon reviewing video surveillance from TD Bank North and other businesses it was confirmed the suspect fled in the direction the K9 tracked to.

Bank Employees were able to describe that the suspect came into the bank and had a black semiautomatic style hand gun in his waist. The suspect demanded money and the Employees on scene complied with his demands. The suspect then left the bank on foot. The suspect was described as a White Male, approximately 5' 8" to 5' 10", and was wearing Kaki style pants, a black hooded Nike sweatshirt, sunglasses, a black cloth over his face, black framed sunglasses and a blue and red cap.

Detectives from the Hudson Criminal Investigative Division and the Hudson Police Crimes Scene Investigative Unit were also called to the scene to process the crime scene and begin the investigation. The investigation into the crime is currently on going.
